MALAYSIA'S PARTICIPATION IN THE 10th WORLD WATER FORUM 2024 BALI, 18 – 21 MAY 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 17 MAY 2024 – Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Energy Transition and Water Transformation, YAB Dato' Sri Haji Fadillah Haji Yusof will lead Malaysia's delegation to the 10th World Water Forum in Bali from 18 to 21 May 2024, at the invitation of the President of the Republic of Indonesia, the Honourable Joko Widodo.

The World Water Forum (WWF), held every three (3) years and jointly organised by the World Water Council (WWC) and the host country, aims to foster global collaborative relationships and promote joint action in addressing new and emerging water management issues through integrated solutions.

Malaysia's participation in the Forum will include the High Level Meeting where Indonesia will lead the discussion to explore innovative solutions to water-related challenges according to the forum theme, Water for Shared Prosperity. The Malaysian delegation is expected to have bilateral meetings with (1) the Honourable Joko Widodo, President of Indonesia, (2) the Honourable Luhut Binsar Pandjaitan, Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investments, (3) Secretary to the Water Convention and other relevant parties.

The meetings will discuss the progress of bilateral relations, particularly future cooperation and collaborative efforts to enhance water sustainability, sharing innovative solutions to tackle water-related issues in the region as well as globally.

This Forum is expected to reaffirm Malaysia's commitment to ensuring sustainable utilisation of water, security of water supply and creating economic opportunities. Malaysia through the Ministry of Energy Transition and Water Transformation will focus on innovative solutions to address emerging water challenges, such as the change in precipitation patterns and extreme weather events.
