PARTICIPATION OF THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF ENERGY TRANSITION AND WATER TRANSFORMATION (PETRA) TO THE 15TH APEC ENERGY MINISTERIAL MEETING, 16TH CLEAN ENERGY MINISTERIAL AND 10TH MISSION INNOVATION IN BUSAN, REPUBLIC OF KOREA

**BUSAN**, **24 AUGUST 2025** – The Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Energy Transition and Water Transformation (PETRA), YAB Dato' Sri Haji Fadillah Haji Yusof, will lead Malaysia's delegation to the 15th APEC Energy Ministers Meeting (APEC EMM15), to be held from 27 to 28 August 2025 in Busan, Republic of Korea.

APEC EMM15 serves as the premier platform at ministerial level for economies to deliberate on energy policies, strategies, and cooperation. More than 100 participants, including Energy Ministers, senior government officials, and industry leaders across APEC, are expected to attend. The discussions will be guided by the theme "Accelerating Sustainable, Affordable, Reliable, Secure and Innovative Energy for a Prosperous Future" and will conclude with the adoption of the Joint Ministerial Statement (JMS).

During the meeting, the Deputy Prime Minister will highlight Malaysia's aspirations to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 through the implementation of the National Energy Transition Roadmap

(NETR) and the New Industrial Master Plan (NIMP) 2030. Malaysia's participation will also underscore the country's role as a strategic partner in regional energy cooperation and as a destination for clean, sustainable, and high-value green investment.

In addition to APEC EMM15, YAB Minister will take part in a roundtable dialogue at the 16th Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM16), the 10th Mission Innovation Ministerial (MI-10), and the 2025 World Climate Industry EXPO (WCE). The Deputy Prime Minister is also scheduled to hold bilateral meetings with counterparts from the Republic of Korea, Hong Kong China, New Zealand and Brunei Darussalam to broaden cooperation in the energy sector, particularly in advancing Malaysia's energy transition agenda.

As part of the official programme, the Deputy Prime Minister will undertake working visits to Korea Hydro and Nuclear Power (KHNP) – Saeul Nuclear Power Plant and Doosan Enerbility, to explore opportunities in training, technology transfer, and technical expertise relating to nuclear energy operations. The official visit will conclude with a tour of the Gangbyeon Wastewater Treatment Plant in Busan.

Malaysia's participation in APEC EMM15 not only strengthens the nation's position in regional energy cooperation but is also aligned with the aspirations of Malaysia MADANI, which emphasize the principles of sustainability, well-being, and innovation to ensure a sustainable, inclusive, and resilient energy future for the people and the nation.
